

PROCLAMATION BY
PRINCIPAL CHIEF MICHELL A. HICKS
OF A
STATE OF EMERGENCY
DATE: JANUARY 30, 2010

- Section 1. Pursuant to the Code of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians Emergency Management Ordinance, Chapter 166 Article II, I have determined that a state of Emergency as defined therein exists on Trust Property of the Tribe through out the six county service areas.
- Section 2. I, therefore, proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency on the Cherokee Indian Reservation (Qualla Boundary, Snowbird and Cherokee County Tracts).
- Section 3. I, hereby order all Tribal Public Safety employees (Police, Fire, Emergency Medical Services, Emergency Management, Animal Control, and Natural Resources) subject to my control cooperate in the enforcement and implementation of provision necessary to address and abate the emergency.
- Section 4. I, hereby order that motorist cease traveling through the Cherokee area after sun down unless it is an emergency or residents are traveling to shelters. Public Safety Officers are ordered to direct motorist to return to their home or local dwelling points (motels and hotels) if their travels are inconsistent with this section.
- Section 5. This proclamation shall become effective immediate of the date, time and signature of the Principal Chief and shall cease at 4:30 PM Eastern time January 31, 2010
